The goal of the Project MĂ IMPLIC in Phase 2

aims to contribute to strengthening local governance and increasing the citizens's access to better public services

Implementation period:

Phase II: November 2023 – October 2027 (4 years)

Implementer: Skat Consulting Ltd.

Donor: Swiss Agency for Development and Cooperation (SDC)

Budget: 6.96 million Swiss francs

Partners: State Chancellery; Ministry of Infrastructure and Regional Development; Ministry of Finance; Ministry of Environment.


